

- 1. Unlock the Electric Middle Box Latch, tilt the box backward.
- 2. Inside you will see Figure 1 set up.
- 3. Disconnect A & B, then connect B & C, and you will hear a click, as the brakes get disconnected.
- 4. You can now start pushing your machine to the desired location.
- 5. Once the machine is in the desired place, please do not forget to connect back A and B.
